## IT systems @ LLV

<u>Sentral</u> is the new Compass. They are both student information systems. They contain contact, timetable, learning support and wellbeing information. They should enable better communication between home and school. Slightly different functionality in app and browser.

<u>Canvas</u> is a learning management system, focussed on coursework and material covered in class. You can see assignments that your child has submitted, teacher feedback on these and (depending on the assignment) the rubric which assesses the child's work on the Master to Novice scale. Works better on a browser than in the app.

<u>Seesaw</u> is a bit like a basic version of Canvas with an emphasis on pictures with explanations and is for K-2 primary students only.

Octopus is a reporting tool that takes data from Canvas to give parents feedback on student progress. It will be an ongoing student report, and will replace the traditional twice yearly academic report. It will operate initially only for years 1 to 10. Years K, 11 and 12 will have their reports published through Sentral as they have unique reporting requirements that don't work inside Octopus. Without overstating it Octopus is most likely a world first. We will be able to implement "live and continuous outcomes based reporting". Octopus will show the child's achievement at the level of an individual curriculum outcome in a task over time. We will still show semester summaries using our learning progression of Master to Novice (aligns to A to E). Octopus should be live by the end of term 1.

Schoolbytes is a payment portal that integrates with Sentral. Links to payments will be sent through Schoolbytes or Sentral.

Munch Monitor is an online ordering system for parents and students.
